

We are finishing the 2021 year with great accomplishments within the Society, in spite of the global challenges and constraints imposed on all of us by the COVID-19 pandemic.

We held a very successful ACES2021 Conference, in August, purely Online, with about 200 excellent papers and presentations that ran live with a lot of interactive discussions, eight engaging live plenary talks, seven industry tutorials, virtual social program, and 215 registered attendees. Our ACES-China-2021 Conference was held in July in Chengdu, China, in a hybrid format with both in-person and virtual participation, more than 500 papers, and outstanding program too.
