


ACES Society is constantly growing up and the next ACES 2016 Conference will be a great event. See you all there!



#### **ACES Annual Awards**

The Applied Computational Electromagnetics Society (ACES) has established the following annual awards for individuals who have made significant contributions to the technical areas of interest to ACES and individuals who have offered significant services to the cociety. This Call for Nominations is for the following four awards:

- ACES Computational Electromagnetics Award
- ACES Technical Achievement Award
- ACES Meritorious Service Award
- ACES Early Career Award

The awards will be given each year at the Awards Banquet at the ACES Annual Conference. The following is a description of the four awards:

#### **ACES Computational Electromagnetics Award:**

To honor career achievements and substantial, major contributions in the field of computational electromagnetics.

2014 winner: Edmund K. Miller 2015 winner: Weng Cho Chew

#### **ACES Technical Achievement Award:**

To honor one or more demonstrated original technical contributions in the field of applied computational electromagnetics, supported by publications, patents, and other products such as developed computer codes.

2014 winner: Jianming Jin 2015 winner: Douglas H. Werner

#### **ACES Meritorious Service Award:**

To honor outstanding and dedicated service to ACES over a long period of time. Technical contributions are not a factor in this Award.

2014 winner: Sami Barmada 2015 winner: Alistair Duffy

#### **ACES Early Career Award:**

To honor achievements and contributions in the field of computational electromagnetics by a researcher aged 35 years or younger at the time of nomination.

2014 winner: Khaled ElMahgoub

2015 winner: Zhen Peng

No more than one recipient of each of the four awards will be selected each year. Nomination forms are available on the ACES web site under the "Elections/Awards" tab. Nominations must be submitted by an ACES member, but supporting letters may come from individuals not affiliated with ACES. The ACES Awards Committee will select recipients and notify the nominators of the outcome. If no suitable nominations are submitted, the Awards Committee may select recipients from the current ACES membership at their own discretion. Preference for the ACES Computational Electromagnetics Award will be given to ACES members, although it may be awarded to non-members at the Awards Committee's discretion; the other awards are restricted to members of ACES with preference given to individuals who have maintained ACES membership for at least a 5-year period.

#### **Call for Nominations for ACES Fellow**

The grade of Fellow is bestowed by the ACES Board of Directors upon a person with exceptional achievements in computational electromagnetics, including ACES publications, and extensive service to ACES. The candidate, the nominator, and the references must be members of ACES in the nomination year and the year this honor is bestowed.

All nomination materials should be uploaded through the website, no later than October 15, 2015.

## Nomination for New Members for ACES Board of Directors

The nomination for new members for the Board of Directors for ACES for the period of 2016-2019 is now open. The nominator must be a member of ACES at the time of nomination and the nominee must be a continuous member of ACES and in good standing at the time of nomination and election, and throughout the period of service on the board, if elected.

You are invited to submit name(s) of nominee(s) for the Board to ACES Elections and Nominations Committee Chair, Keefe Coburn, <a href="keefecoburn@comcast.net">keefecoburn@comcast.net</a>. It is desirable for you to check with your nominee on his/her membership status at ACES, and if they accept the nomination.

Acceptance from the nominee, and a short biography for posting on the ACES website, should be provided by e-mail to the ACES Elections and Nominations Committee Chair. *The nomination must be received by ACES by the deadline of Sunday, November 22, 2015.* The Board of Directors will finalize the list of nominees in a meeting in late November/early December.

On-line voting will be open to ACES members in the period of December 1, 2015 to January 15, 2016. Active membership in ACES at the time of voting is required to vote. Elected members of the Board will be invited to the Board of Directors meeting at the 2016 ACES Conference in Honolulu, Hawaii.
